



## Audrey Bosboom

Audrey was admitted to practice in December 1993. She worked in a general legal practice for two years before finding her niche in personal injury law, initially in workers compensation and then CTP insurance.

Audrey worked at Finlaysons Lawyers from 1999 to 2004, during which time she became a Senior Associate, specialising in motor vehicle accident claims. After working for Thomson Playford's general insurance team, Audrey commenced employment as a Senior Solicitor with the Crown Solicitor's Office in 2007. She has defended claims against various government agencies, particularly the Department of Health.

Audrey has appeared as counsel in the Coroner's Court in relation to deaths in public hospitals, as well as the SA Employment Tribunal with respect to workers compensation and asbestos claims, often at short notice.

Since joining the bar in April 2019, Audrey has been engaged by various personal injury and insurance firms across Adelaide and has represented workers at the SAET through to hearing and determination. She co-founded Nyland Chambers in 2021.

In 2023, Audrey was recognised in Doyle's Guide as a Preeminent Barrister in Insurance and Personal Injury Law.
